

POSTDOCTORAL RESEARCHER POSITION

Phase-Change Heat Transfer and Advanced Thermal Management

The **Nano-Energy Laboratory**, led by **Prof. Ming-Chang Lu** (呂明璋) in the Department of Mechanical Engineering at **National Taiwan University (NTU)**, invites applications for a **Postdoctoral Researcher** position.

The successful candidate will conduct research in **phase-change heat transfer and advanced thermal management**, with emphasis on:

- **Pool boiling** on engineered micro/nanostructured surfaces
- **Flow boiling** in channels for high-heat-flux cooling
- **Numerical simulation and design of liquid cold plates**

The research will combine **fundamental heat-transfer studies, experiments, and numerical modeling** for applications in **high-power electronics and semiconductor thermal management**.

Qualifications

Applicants should:

- Hold, or expect to soon receive, a **Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering, Thermal Engineering, Energy Engineering, or a related field**
- Have a strong background in **phase-change heat transfer**
- Have demonstrated research ability through peer-reviewed journal publications
- Have good scientific writing and communication skills in English

Experience in pool boiling, flow boiling, and phase-change heat transfer is particularly desirable.

- Appointment: Initial one-year appointment, with the possibility of renewal based on performance and funding availability
- Compensation: Monthly salary starting from approximately NT\$65,000, commensurate with qualifications and experience
